EVS opportunities

The European Voluntary Service (EVS) offers young people under 30 to do a voluntary job abroad, with all their expenses covered. Several participating organizations offer a wide range of voluntary jobs in the fields of cultural, environmental, sport, media and social activities so everybody can find a program which fits their interest the best. The volunteer has to work 30-35 hours per week at the chosen hosting organization, and is given predetermined number of free days and language course. The length of the projects are between 2 weeks and 12 months.

To be an an EVS volunteer, you need a sending organization which will prepare you for the big adventure and helps you during the time you spend abroad. We are also an organization like this so if you want to apply for any opportunities listed here or another project, we are here to help you.

Trainings

Almost every Erasmus+ Training Course is free, participants are provided with accommodation and meals, most of the time their travel costs are also reimbursed. For some of the trainings, the National Agency can charge an administration fee of 10.000 Ft, in exchange for this, they bear all costs, including both the travel and insurance and they help to plan the trip.

The aim of the trainings is to improve the participants' competences and knowledge in international environment with practising the methods of nonformal education. Mainly workshops, group presentations, creative programs and conversations help to understand the topic. Besides the workshops, the program usually consists of a city tour and in the evenings different thematic parties.

However, for the successful application, you either need a relevant experience or plans for the future using the knowledge gained during the event (e.g. organizing a local event, exchange, SU or launching a new program). If you are insecure about the conditions of applying, we help with pleasure. :)
